Dear Parents / Guardians (Our Valued Partners-in-Education)

Here are some updates for May and June 2024.

1. Weighted Assessments (WA) for Primary 3 to 6 levels

We would like to remind you of the school's **Assessment Rules and Regulations**:

- The well-being of our students is of utmost importance. We appeal to parents not to send your child to school to sit for the assessments if he/she is unwell/on medical leave (i.e. with a medical certificate).
- Students are required to submit their medical certificates to their Class Mentors immediately upon return to school.
- There will be no make-up assessments for students who are absent on Weighted Assessment/Examination days even if he/she has a medical certificate.
- No marks will be awarded to the student if he/she is absent from any assessment without a valid medical certificate.

The following table indicates the various actions by the school for students who are absent for any assessments:

Reasons for Absence	Action by School
Absent without a valid reason	No marks will be awarded for the assessments not sat for
Absent with a Medical Certificate	Component(s)/paper(s) not sat for will not be used for the computation of the Overall Subject Results

- Students will not be allowed to take the assessment if they are
 - late for more than 15 mins for papers with duration of 1 hour or less, *OR*
 - late for more than 30 mins for papers with duration of more than 1 hour.
- Students who are late will not be given extra time to complete the assessment.
- As part of the school's efforts to support and monitor students' learning, absentees will be given a copy of the papers they did not sit for **as a practice** after they have recovered and returned to school.

2. Parent-Child-Teacher Conference (PCTC)/Parent-Teacher Conference (PTC) on Thursday, 23 May and Friday, 24 May

Parent-Child-Teacher Conference (PCTC) in school for Primary 1 to 2 students:

Primary 1 to 2 students need not report to school on these two days. However, to facilitate the PCTC, parents are to bring your child/ward along during your selected time slot. Work on Student Learning Space (SLS) will also be assigned for all Primary 1 to 2 students to be completed at home.

Parent-Teacher Conference (PTC) via Zoom for Primary 3 to 6 students:

Primary 3 to 6 students need not report to school on these two days. Instead, they will be assigned work on Student Learning Space (SLS) to be completed at home.

All appointment bookings with Class Mentors will open on Wednesday, 8 May (1200h) and will close on Wednesday, 15 May via Parent Gateway (PG). Appointments are booked on a first-come-first-serve basis.

3. Well-being of Students

In consideration of the hot and humid weather, students may choose to wear PE attire to school on non-PE days with effect from 1 April 2024. This arrangement will be in place till 23 June 2024. The school will review the need for this to be extended, depending on the weather. P4 to P6 students are to wear PE shirt with school pants or skirts. They have been reminded to be neat and tidy while in their PE attire. We seek your support to ensure your child/ward wears a clean and fresh PE shirt for hygiene purposes.

4. P6 June Study Camp from Wednesday, 19 June to Friday, 21 June

To support our graduating students in their journey towards PSLE, our school has planned a Study Camp for your child / ward during the June Holidays. A separate notification on the P6 June Study Camp has been sent to you via Parent Gateway on 19 April.

Please note that your child's / ward's attendance at the Study Camp is compulsory. We sincerely seek your support in ensuring their participation, as their active involvement will greatly contribute to their academic development and overall success in the PSLE.

5. Public Holidays

Please take note that Labour Day and Vesak Day fall on Wednesdays, 01 May and 22 May respectively.

6. June Holidays (Saturday 25 May to Sunday, 23 June)

The school holidays will begin from Saturday, 25 May to Sunday, 23 June. The new school semester begins on Monday, 24 June for all students.

7. Travel Declaration for June Holidays

You are required to make a travel declaration if you have plans for your child/ward to travel during the June holidays. A separate notification on travel declaration will be sent to you in due time.

We would like to take this opportunity to express my appreciation to parents and stakeholders for all your support and understanding as we work together on your child/ ward's educational journey. Do encourage your child/ward to read and enjoy learning beyond the classroom during the holidays. We wish you happy holidays in June; stay safe and stay healthy.
