Dear Parents / Guardians (Our Valued Partners-in-Education)

Here are some updates for October 2022.

1. Children's Day Celebration and Children's Day School Holiday (Thursday, 6 October and Friday, 7 October 2022)

The school will be celebrating Children's Day on Thursday, 6 October 2022. Students will report to school **as usual** on that day. The school will be closed on Friday, 7 October 2022 for Children's Day.

The recess timings for Primary 3 and 6 levels will be from 9am to 9.30am on Thursday, 6 October. The recess timings for the rest of the levels remain the same. As part of the celebration, during recesses on Thursday, 6 October, in addition to the usual items, the school canteen vendors will be selling, on an **exceptional basis**, some snacks and food items such as chicken burger, hotdog pasta, chicken popcorns, satays, chips, fruit jelly – items that students have indicated they would like to have on 6 October. The prices ranged from \$0.30 to \$2.30. We thank the canteen vendors who put in the extra efforts to bring cheer to the children.

2. 2022 PSLE Marking Exercise

The 2022 PSLE Marking Exercise will be held on 17 October (Monday) to 20 October (Thursday). Students are not required to report to school on those day and will stay at home to revise for their upcoming semestral assessment, as well as spend quality interaction time with you. However, school will be open to selected students on 17 October (Monday) and 18 October (Tuesday) for consultation with their subject teachers. Should your child/ward be selected for the consultation sessions, separate consent forms will be issued to them by their subject teachers. School will resume on 21 October (Friday) for all students.

3. End-of-Year Examinations (EYE)

We would like to inform parents of the school's assessment guidelines:

- There will be no make-up papers for students who are absent on Written Paper (including Listening Comprehension) examination days.
- Students who are on medical leave are required to produce medical certificates (MC) immediately upon return to school. His/her marks will be computed accordingly. No marks will be awarded for the subject if no medical certificate is produced.
- Students who are tested positive for COVID-19 and absent from Written Paper (including Listening Comprehension) examination would not be required to produce MC, doctor's letter or recovery memo to cover their absence. However, Class Mentors (CMs) are to have sight of the affected student's SMS from MOH or photo evidence of the positive ART result.
- Students who are unwell are advised to rest at home and not sit for their Written Paper examination.
- Students who arrive 30 minutes or later after the examination paper has started will not be allowed to sit for the paper. No marks will be awarded for that paper.
- Year-end oral examinations will be conducted after school. Students will be dismissed from school once they have completed their oral examination for the day. Please make necessary transport arrangements for your child/ward.
- On the designated oral examination days for the level, your child/ward will be sitting for either his/her English or Mother Tongue Language Oral Examination on the first day and the other language oral examination on the second day.
- Should your child/ward be absent on their oral examination day, a make-up oral examination will be conducted for them on 21 October Friday.
