5. 2024 PSLE Listening Comprehension (Friday, 13 September)

The PSLE Listening Comprehension will be held on Friday, 13 September. **P1 to P5 students** <u>do not</u> need to report to school on that day. They will complete their home-based learning at home.

6. Home-Based Learning (HBL) for Primary 1 and 2 during PSLE Written Examination

To provide a conducive environment for our Primary 6 students during the PSLE Written Examination, all Primary 1 and 2 students do not need to report to school from Thursday, 26 September to Tuesday, 01 October. They will complete their HBL at home during this period.

All Primary 3 to 5 students will continue to report to school at the usual school hours for face-to-face lessons from Thursday, 26 September to Wednesday, 02 October.

7. Primary 6 Study Break (Monday, 23 September to Wednesday, 25 September)

The school will be implementing a three-day study break for Primary 6 students from Monday, 23 September to Wednesday, 25 September to support their well-being prior to the PSLE.

During the study break, Primary 6 students are strongly encouraged to remain at home and do their revision. The school will remain open for selected Primary 6 students who require in-school support. Parents/Guardians of selected students will be separately informed. More details on the study break will be shared to parents and students closer to the date.
